

**THE SUMMIT AND MEDINA WORKFORCE AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS  
FOR OHIO LOCAL WORKFORCE AREA 2  
RESOLUTION 2017-28**

**A Resolution authorizing the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments to execute a Subgrant Agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for workforce development programming in Ohio Local Workforce Area 2, received by the Council of Governments during State Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019 (7/1/2017 to 6/30/2019).**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code (the “ORC”) states that the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (“ODJFS”) may only make grants to counties through subgrant agreements as described in that section;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (the “WIOA”), the Summit and Medina County Workforce Area Council of Governments (the “SAMWA COG”) was established as the governance structure that administers the public workforce system in Ohio Local Workforce Area 2 (“Area 2”), which is comprised of Medina and Summit Counties;

**WHEREAS**, the SAMWA COG’s Board has as its members the Chief Elected Officials of Medina and Summit Counties to execute a subgrant agreement with ODJFS for the reception of WIOA funds allocated to Area 2 in State Fiscal Years (“SFY”) 2018 and 2019 (7/1/2017 to 6/30/2019).

**WHEREAS**, the SAMWA COG finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of Area 2 to authorize the execution of a subgrant agreement with ODJFS to receive Area 2’s WIOA grants for SFY 2018 and 2019;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the SAMWA COG that:

**SECTION 1**

The SAMWA COG Board is hereby authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services to receive Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 grants for State Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019 (7/1/2017 to 6/30/2019), allocated to Ohio Local Workforce Area 2 (“Area 2”) for the operation and administration of workforce development programs in Medina and Summit Counties.

**SECTION 2**

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
