

**THE SUMMIT AND MEDINA WORKFORCE AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS  
FOR OHIO LOCAL WORKFORCE AREA 2  
RESOLUTION 2019-15**

**A Resolution authorizing the first renewal of two, awarded by the Workforce Development Board of Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act funds for a Subrecipient Agreement with Jobs' for Ohio's Graduates (JOG), under the State of Ohio's Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program (CCMEP) model, to provide WIOA youth services for the period of 7/1/2019 to 6/30/2020, with one remaining 12-month renewal option.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio's publicly funded youth workforce programs are served through the Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program ("CCMEP") as a single population under a consolidated system of service delivery, and requires the leveraging of federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (the "TANF") and Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services (the "ODJFS") allocates both TANF and WIOA funds to county level Job and Family Services departments and Ohio's designated Local Workforce Areas, respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, in Ohio Local Workforce Area 2 ("Area 2"), comprised of Medina and Summit Counties, TANF funds are received by both the Medina and Summit Counties' Job and Family Services Departments and WIOA funds are received by the Summit & Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments (SAMWA COG); and

**WHEREAS**, with Ohio's consolidation of the delivery of youth services through WIOA and TANF, the United States Department of Labor maintains the requirement that a local Workforce Development Board is responsible for the procurement and monitoring of all services purchased and rendered utilizing WIOA funds, and that this responsibility cannot be transferred to another party thereby resulting in the determination for a joint procurement process with the county level Departments of Job and Family Services; and

**WHEREAS**, on 5/11/18, a joint Request for Proposal packet was released by the Summit/Medina Workforce Development Board (the "WDB") and the Medina County Job and Family Services (the "MCJFS") for the provision of CCMEP youth educational and employment services in Medina County, funded with both TANF and WIOA allocations; and

**WHEREAS**, at its meeting held 6/26/2018, the Medina County Commissioners, adopted Resolution 18-0559, which awarded the TANF portion of a joint TANF- and WIOA-funded CCMEP subrecipient agreement to JOG and at its 6/27/2018 meeting, the SAMWA COG adopted Resolution 2018-12, which awarded of the WIOA portion of a joint TANF- and WIOA-funded CCMEP subrecipient agreement to JOG, with the agreement for the period of 7/1/2018 to 6/30/2019, with two 12-month renewal options, and

**WHEREAS**, at its 6/5/19 meeting, due to meeting performance measures, the WDB Executive Committee recommended to the SAMWA COG the renewal of the WIOA portion of <sup>the</sup> various joint TANF- and WIOA-funded subrecipient agreements, <sup>to JOG</sup> for the period of 7/1/2019 to 6/30/2020, initiating the first of two 12-month renewal options, in a total amount not to exceed \$204,775.00; and

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**WHEREAS**, the SAMWA COG finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information and having received the recommendation of the WDB, that it is necessary and in the best interest of Area 2 to initiate the first of two 12-month renewal options and confirm the WDB's recommendation of the WIOA portion of the jointly funded subrecipient agreement for the provision of CCMEP youth services in Medina County to JOG;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the SAMWA COG, that:

**SECTION 1**

Renewal of the award by the SAMWA COG of a subrecipient agreement to Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, held between JOG, Medina County Job and Family Services, and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments, to provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program model in Medina County, for the period beginning 7/1/19 and ending 6/30/20, with one additional 12-month options to renew, leveraging \$556,036.00 of Temporary Assistance to Needy Family (TANF) funds and \$204,775.00 of Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds in a total amount not to exceed \$760,791.00, is hereby confirmed.

**SECTION 2**

This Directive shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
