A Resolution authorizing the inclusion of Goodwill Industries of Akron, Summit County Developmental Disabilities, Volunteers of America: Ohio and Indiana, Portage Lakes Career Center, Medina Career Center, Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, Serrato Corporation, Jefferson County Community Action Council, Ohio Guidestone, and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments as "Additional Partners", defined in The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA), Section 121(b)(2) to the Sate Fiscal Year 2022 and 2023 Local Workforce Area One-Stop Partner Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

WHEREAS, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (the "WIOA") requires the presence of partners providing certain services identified in WIOA Section 121(b)(1) at all American Job Centers (the "AJC") nationally;

WHEREAS; WIOA Section 121(b)(2) allows entities not identified in Section 121(b)(1) to be included as "Additional Partners" to a Local Workforce Area's Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU"), so long as their inclusion is consistent with WIOA's goals and receives the approval of the Workforce Area's Workforce Development Board (the "WDB") and chief elected officials;

WHEREAS, the Area 2 chief elected officials finds and determines, after review of all pertinent information provided by the Board staff, it accepts the recommendation that it is necessary and in the best interest of Area 2 to authorize the inclusion of Goodwill Industries of Akron, a not-for-profit corporation employment preparation agency; Summit County Developmental Disabilities, a governmental agency focused on empowering persons with disabilities in the workplace; Volunteers of America: Ohio and Indiana, a not-for-profit organization recipient of the United States Department of Labor ("U.S. DOL) Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP) grant; Portage Lakes Career Center; Medina Career Center; Jobs for Ohio's Graduates, a not-for-profit serving youth education and employment needs; Serrato Corporation, a recipient of ("U.S. DOL) Job Corps funding; Jefferson County Community Action Council, a subrecipient of U.S. DOL Reentry Employment Opportunities Pathway Home Grant; Ohio Guidestone, a subrecipient of United States Department of Health and Human Services (U.S. HHS) Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration funding; and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Government, a subrecipient of U.S. DOL Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) funding, as Additional Partner to the Ohio Local Workforce Area 2 (the "Area 2") MOU for State Fiscal Year (the "SFY") 2022 and 2023, and further recommended their presence at the American Job Center located in either/or both Summit or Medina Counties' known in Ohio as OhioMeansJobs (the "OMJ") Centers:
