

**5THE SUMMIT AND MEDINA WORKFORCE AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
FOR OHIO LOCAL WORKFORCE AREA 2
RESOLUTION 2025-17**

A Resolution authorizing the third and final renewal awarded by the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments (SAMWA COG) in the joint contract with the Summit County Department of Job and Family Services (SCDJFS), for the payroll services of NESCO Resource, LLC during the period of 10/01/2025 through 9/30/2026, for youth and young adults participating in work experience under the Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program (CCMEP), in a minimum amount of \$200,000.00 of Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio's publicly funded youth workforce programs are served through the Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program ("CCMEP") as a single population under a consolidated system of service delivery, and requires the leveraging of federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") and Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act ("WIOA") funds;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services ("ODJFS") allocates TANF and WIOA funds to county level Job and Family Services departments and Ohio's 20 designated Local Workforce Areas, respectively;

WHEREAS, in Ohio Local Workforce Area 2 ("Area 2"), comprised of Medina and Summit Counties, the TANF funds are received by both the Medina and Summit Counties' Job and Family Services departments and WIOA funds are received by the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA COG");

WHEREAS, with Ohio's consolidation of the delivery of youth services through WIOA and TANF, the United States Department of Labor maintains the requirement that local Workforce Development Boards are responsible for the procurement and monitoring of all contractor agreements purchased and rendered utilizing WIOA funds, and that this responsibility cannot be transferred to another party, thereby resulting in the determination for a joint procurement process with the county level Job and Family Services departments;

WHEREAS, the SAMWA COG and SCDJFS entered into a Contractor Agreement with Nesco Resources, LLC (the parties) for FFY 2023 on or about October 25, 2022 for Payroll Services for Summit County Youth and Young Adult Employment Programs under the Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program (CCMEP) with the original Agreement consisting of a one (1) year contract with three (3) additional annual renewal options; and

WHEREAS, the parties renewed the Contractor Agreement for FFY2024 in order to provide for continued Payroll Services on or about September 25, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the parties amended the Contractor Agreement for FFY 2023 on or about October 12, 2023, in order to increase the compensation amount; and

WHEREAS, the parties amended the Contractor Agreement for FFY 2024 on or about May 10, 2024, in order to increase the compensation amount; and

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WHEREAS, the parties again amended the Contractor Agreement for FFY 2024 on or about September 12, 2024, in order to increase the compensation amount; and

WHEREAS, the parties again renewed the Contractor Agreement for FFY2025 in order to provide for continued Payroll Services on or about October 23, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereby agree that it is now necessary to renew the Contractor Agreement for FFY 2026, for the third and final renewal period of 10/01/25 to 9/30/26 in order to provide for continued Payroll Services; and

WHEREAS, the SAMWA COG finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interests of Area 2 to confirm the third and final renewal of the WIOA funds for the aforementioned TANF-funded and WIOA-funded Contractor Agreement to Nesco Resource, LLC for the provision of CCMEP work experience payroll services in Summit County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the SAMWA COG, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the SAMWA COG of WIOA funds for a contractor agreement, jointly funded by WIOA and TANF, to Nesco Resource, LLC held between Nesco Resource, LLC the SCDJFS, and the SAMWA COG, to provide payroll services to CCMEP youth and young adults participating in work experience, awarding a third renewal for the period of 10/01/2025 to 09/30/2026, with no remaining renewal options in the minimum amount of \$200,000.00, is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2

This directive shall be retroactively effective as of October 1, 2025.
