OMJ Center Orientation 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM Offered in-person or virtually.

Receive an overview of services offered by OhioMeansJobs | Medina County and its Partners, register for WIOA Career Services, and then create an OMJ profile and upload your résumé to OhioMeansJobs.com so that employers can find you. Next, meet with our team to discuss your most immediate job search and training needs.

What to bring:

- 1. Two (2) forms of valid ID
- 2. Electronic résumé. If you do not have a résumé, we will need to create one for you.
- 3. DD-214 if you are a Veteran
- 4. Unemployment Determination Letter if receiving or exhausted UI benefits
- 5. OhioMeansJobs.com username and password

This three-day workshop covers important aspects of an effective job-search strategy, including resumes, interviewing, and Applicant Tracking Systems (ATS). Participants who complete Career Workshop are then paired with an Employment Specialist or Career Counselor to provide individualized career assistance to them throughout their job search. Those seeking WIOA funding for occupational skills training will be paired with a Training Specialist.

Computer and Internet Skills Workshop 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM Prior registration required. Offered in-person.

This workshop will focus on basic computer skills, including the operation of PCs, using word processors and other software relevant to the job market, exploring the Internet, email, and internet safety. The class will be organized into a two-hour session divided between instruction and practical application; students will engage with lecture materials by operating computers to execute web searches, learn basic key commands, and create and edit documents and emails.
